

Northwestern's Campus Master Plan 2012 to present

The current campus master plan was developed in 2011–12 in consultation with Credo and with input from faculty, staff, students, trustees, and key alumni and community members. It was approved as part of the Strategic Plan by the Board of Trustees in April 2012.

Components completed:

1. RSC 4-court renovation | Fall 2011
2. Soccer field construction and renovation (scoreboard, lights, fence and press box as well as irrigation, drainage and reseeding) | Fall 2011 and Fall 2013
3. North Suites construction | Fall 2012
4. Translation & interpretation lab installation | Fall 2012
5. Cafeteria and Vermeer Dining Room renovation | Fall 2013
6. RSC fitness/game/racquetball courts renovation | Fall 2013
7. DeWitt Learning Commons construction | Fall 2013
8. Van Peurseem Hall science labs renovation (3rd and 1st floors) | Fall 2013
9. West Hall demolition | Summer 2014
10. Ramaker Center renovation (for student services) | Fall 2014
 - Athletic offices relocated to former student life offices in RSC
 - Coaching offices in Bultman Center expanded into former athletic offices
 - Kinesiology lab/classroom relocated from Bultman Center hallway to RSC
11. Juffer Fieldhouse construction | Fall 2015
 - Wrestling relocated to Bultman weight room (athletes' weight room relocated to Juffer)
 - Dance room restored in Bultman Center
12. Sidewalk addition (between Ramaker Center and Bultman Center) | Fall 2017
13. Health and natural sciences center construction | Fall 2018

Components remaining:

1. Renovate or replace aging residence halls
2. Renovate or demolish Kepp Hall
3. Construct a Welcome Center for admissions and possibly other offices
4. Construct soccer field concession stand and restrooms
5. Install campus entrance markers, landscaping, paths/plazas, lighting, parking to improve traffic for pedestrians and vehicles (Hwy 10 and Albany Ave.)
6. Construct addition to the Korver Visual Arts Center
7. Construct addition to the Maintenance Building
