Northwestern offers several \$1,000 James L. Franken Servant Leadership Scholarships. The scholarships are available to incoming freshman students with outstanding leadership abilities and a desire to grow in those abilities while a student at Northwestern. To be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must have a minimum high school GPA of 3.0 and an ACT score (or SAT equivalent) of 21 or above.

To apply, email the following to Dr. Sandi Altena (sandra.altena@nwcsiowa.edu), director of the Franken Leadership Center at Northwestern College:

- This completed application form
- A one-page essay reflecting on at least one of the core values of James L. Franken and the Interstates Companies where he served as president/CEO: servant leadership, dependability, integrity, trust, quality or family. Identify why you selected the particular value and how it relates to you.
- A letter of recommendation from one of your high school teachers

If you are chosen to receive a Franken Servant Leadership Scholarship, you will enroll in a 4-credit leadership course offered by the Franken Leadership Center during one of your first four semesters. (This leadership course fulfills one of the college's Integrated General Education, or IGE, requirements.)
