

# NURSING DEPARTMENTAL SCHOLARSHIP

## ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a new entering freshman accepted for admission to Northwestern College's pre-nursing program and have submitted the nursing program deposit.
2. Have a projected Northwestern College cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 (this information will be provided to the nursing department by the admissions office).
3. Write a 250- to 500-word essay about why you want to study nursing and how you plan to integrate your faith in your life as a nurse. The essay should introduce yourself, note any financial need, and explain how you hope to serve as a Christian nurse.
4. Submit a letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or counselor familiar with your character and academic abilities.
5. Be willing to make application through the department, provide requested information, and participate in an on- campus or phone interview.

## PROCESS OF APPLICATION

If you meet the eligibility standards stated above, make application directly through the Department of Nursing. Be sure your application materials include:

- Cover letter
- Essay
- Letter of recommendation

Students who receive the Nursing Departmental Scholarship are still eligible for other scholarships and aid available through the admissions or financial aid offices.

All materials must be received by January 10. Any on-campus or phone interview will be completed by February 5.
