Boost your nursing career. Northwestern's online RN to BSN accommodates the schedules of working nurses and can be completed in 2 years or less. You'll get an excellent education at a cost that's competitive.

Earn your BSN

Northwestern's online RN to BSN completion option enables working nurses to graduate in 2 years or less while taking just one 8-week course at a time (two courses each semester). The program is distinguished by courses that offer valuable theory and practical knowledge and an accommodating clinical requirement. It's designed specifically for nurses who graduated from associate degree or hospital diploma nursing programs; applicants must be residents of IA, MN, SD or NE.

Tuition and financial aid

Tuition for Northwestern's RN to BSN online option is competitive with similar programs in Iowa and South Dakota*.
