Learning's a trip

Study abroad for a semester or a summer month with the support of Northwestern's Global Education Center. Choose a partner program or one of 2 programs hosted by Northwestern:

Oman Semester in Muscat

Live in the Middle East and learn about interfaith dialogue through the Al Amana Centre, a Reformed Church in America mission dedicated to encouraging understanding between Christians and Muslims. This semester-by-the-sea includes study of Arabic and Middle Eastern history and politics as well as camel rides and hiking in Oman's Grand Canyon.

Transylvania Semester in Lupeni

Learn about sustainable community development in a post-communist country struggling to rebuild social trust. You'll partner with the New Horizons Foundation, a non-governmental agency dedicated to teaching youth self-confidence and teamwork through clubs, camps and experiential education.

Partnership programs

Through partnerships with other organizations, we can help you enroll in approved programs in more than 20 countries, including Belize, Costa Rica, England, Jordan, Mexico, New Zealand, the Netherlands, Spain and Uganda.

Summer study abroad

Explore other shores through a month-long summer trip if you can't afford to spend a whole semester abroad. Northwestern professors lead 3- to 4-week courses in a variety of academic areas and countries. Most take place early in the summer and meet the college's cross-cultural general education requirement. Recent trips:
