I would like to see more emphasis placed on professional responsibilities like the importance of daily attendance and daily lesson planning. It is frustrating when you have to remind first year teachers to be here on a daily basis and how to design effective lesson plans. I feel a lot of young teacher candidates are too caught up in their own personal lives to focus on their professional teaching responsibilities and don't really want to put in the time it takes to be a teacher, only take advantage of contractual benefits.

Use of SmartBoard technology is lacking. I'm finding that to be true of all recent grads, not just NWC. Also the use of technology for instruction in general. Teachers need to know the pedagogical skills that incorporate technology following the SAMR model. Technology is more than just use a SmartBoard as an overhead projector or doing research on the internet.
