TEST LOCATION: Room 301 or 313 (depending on the day of the week), in Van Peurse Hall

TESTING PROCEDURES:

The complete test battery includes a 40-minute writing exercise and a multiple-choice component divided into four subjects, English, mathematics, science and social studies. Each subject area of C-BASE test takes approximately 40 minutes to complete.

You should arrive at the test site 20 minutes prior to the testing time. Late arrivals will not be admitted. Students will need to check-in with the test proctor and present a current form of identification (driver's license or student ID). Please remember to bring #2 pencils to complete the exam.

Calculators are not provided, but you may use your own hand-held, non-printing, four or six function calculator during the examination. Scientific or graphing calculators are not allowed. Students are not allowed to share calculators or use any other material not provided with the exam.

During the multiple-choice sections, you may answer the questions in any order you choose and you may return to any section in the multiple-choice part of the exam during the testing period.

C-BASE does not penalize you for guessing. Every correct answer counts toward your scores, so you should try to answer every question. An informed guess is better than no answer. During the test, the proctor will periodically post the time remaining.

SPECIAL ACCOMMODATIONS:

Reasonable accommodations will be provided to any individual who presents documentation of a physical or mental disability. **Test takers must request accommodations at the time of registration.** Test takers will meet with John Menning in Academic Support to be approved for accommodations.
