TESTING PROCEDURES:

The complete test battery includes a 40-minute writing exercise and a multiple-choice component divided into four subjects, English, mathematics, science and social studies. Each subject area of C-BASE test takes approximately 45 minutes to complete.

Late arrivals may not be admitted.

Students will need to check-in with the test proctor and present a current form of identification (driver's license or student ID).

Please remember to bring #2 pencils to complete the exam.

Calculators are provided.

Scratch paper is provided.

No food or beverage is allowed.

During the multiple-choice sections, you may answer the questions in any order you choose and you may return to any section in the multiple-choice part of the exam during the testing period.

C-BASE does not penalize you for guessing. Every correct answer counts toward your scores, so you should try to answer every question. An informed guess is better than no answer. During the test, the proctor will periodically post the time remaining.
