

C. Independent Student’s Income Information

C1. STUDENT TAX FILER - Complete **C1** if the student (and/or spouse) filed a 2023 IRS income tax return.

- **Note:** Students (and spouse, if married) will be required to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt is ineffective. If the student and spouse filed separate 2023 tax returns, both must provide consent to import tax information from the IRS.

Check the box below that applies:

- The student (and spouse) has used the IRS Data Exchange to transfer 2023 IRS tax information into the FAFSA.
- The student (and spouse) is unable to use the IRS Data Exchange and plans to send the school a **signed** copy of their 2023 IRS Federal 1040 Tax Return with Schedules 1-3 (if applicable). Please fax the **signed** copies to 712-707-7165. **Do not email IRS Tax Returns due to social security numbers.**
- The student (and spouse) is unable to use the IRS Data Exchange and plans to send the school a 2023 Tax Return Transcript, which can be obtained online at <https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript>. Choose either option presented on the website: Get Transcript Online or Get Transcript by Mail. Make sure you order a 2023 “Tax Return” Transcript, as there are several different types.

C2. STUDENT NONTAX FILER - Complete **C2** only if the student did not file and is not required to file a 2023 income tax return with the IRS.

Check the box that applies:

- The student was not employed and had no income earned from work in 2023.
- The student was employed in 2023 and has listed below the names of all the student’s employers and the amount earned from each employer in 2023. Attach copies of all 2023 W-2 forms issued to the student by employers. List every employer even if they did not issue a W-2 form.
